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Components, activities, competencies, and capacities

- Many community agencies did not feel they were part of the local public health system
- Many survey responses were marked No Knowledge
- Greatest health challenges- highly complex
- To ensure health equity must address social determinants

Together these findings indicate a need to educate the community and stakeholders about public health and provide resources to build capacity

Needed a **Health in All Policies Approach** to make changes

Health in All Policies (HiAP) is:

A change in the systems that determine how decisions are made and implemented by agencies to ensure that public policies, plans, projects and programs have neutral or beneficial impacts on the determinants of health

HiAP- Health in All Policies

7 key Components

- 1. Support collaboration-shared direction
- 2. Benefit multiple partners
- Engage traditional and nontraditional stakeholdersbuild capacity
- 4. Create structural or process change- training
- 5. Promote health equity & sustainability- social determinants
- 6. Accountability, transparency and participatory processes
- 7. Practical cross-sector initiatives build partnerships and trust
